Mayor Bustle called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Brian Bustle, Church on the Rock, gave the invocation, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States.

1. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

MOTION: Ms. Bryant moved, Mr. Williams seconded and motion carried 5-0 to approve the September 16, 2002 agenda.

2. 1ST PUBLIC HEARING - TENTATIVE MILLAGE & TENTATIVE BUDGET

Mayor Bustle summarized the efforts City Council and staff to reach a tentative budget. He explained the proposed 5.1645 millage rate had been reduced to a tentative millage rate of 4.6645%, which is 20.03% over the rolled back rate. Mayor Bustle also discussed the tiered salary increases for the employees and police officers of the city.

Mayor Bustle opened the public hearing.

Residents Phil Guercio and Jonathan Davis expressed their opinion on the proposed budget, stating the millage should not be raised. Mr. Guercio presented a list of questions for the Mayor and City Council, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part of these minutes.

Mayor Bustle closed the public hearing.

Attorney Prather read Resolution No. 02-12 in its entirety.

Mayor Bustle opened the public hearing. Staff requested the hearing be continued to October 7, 2002 to allow for the Joint Planning Committee review.

MOTION: Mr. Williams moved, Ms. Bryant seconded and motion carried 5-0 to continue the public hearing to October 7, 2002.

**12. PUBLIC HEARING - ORDINANCE NO. 02-758
Ordinance No. 02-758 was read by title.**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALMETTO, FLORIDA APPROVING A GENERAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR THE VILLAS AT OAK BEND ATTACHED HERETO AS EXHIBIT "A"; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. (Z0216 THE VILLAS AT OAK BEND/Kendar-Marsac Development Company; 8.27 acres)

Mrs. Tusing informed Council the Tree Preservation Plan she distributed was fulfilling a condition established by the Planning & Zoning Board. The remaining conditions will be met before the final plat approval. Density and on-street parking were discussed. Council indicated its desire that on-street parking be discouraged, even though there is no code prohibiting street parking in the development. The developer stated property at the pool area could be utilized for additional parking. The developer also informed Council the

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plans called for a t-intersection so connection to the City's water & sewer could be made when the service is available. The Homeowner Association's documents will be submitted for approval when the construction plans come to Council for approval.

Mayor Bustle opened the public hearing. There was no public comment, meeting was closed.

MOTION: Mr. Williams moved, Ms. Tusing seconded and motion carried 3-2 to adopt Ordinance No. 02-758 with the additional of the Tree Preservation Plan. Mrs. Lancaster and Mr. Grace voted no.

13. PRELIMINARY PLAT APPROVAL - THE VILLAS AT OAK BEND

MOTION: Ms. Cornwell moved, Ms. Bryant seconded and motion carried 3-2 to approve the Preliminary Plat for the Villas at Oak Bend with the recommended listed conditions as read by Ms. Bryant. Mrs. Lancaster and Mr. Grace voted no.

14. PRELIMINARY PLAT APPROVAL - PALMETTO PLANTATION

MOTION: Ms. Cornwell moved, Mrs. Bryant seconded and motion carried 5-0 to approve the Preliminary Plat for Palmetto Plantation with the conditional approval as recommended.

15. MANATEE COUNTY RADIO CONTROLLERS, INC. LEASE AGREEMENT

Mayor Bustle noted the new lease agreement before Council was for a term of ten years. Ms. Cornwell referred to Section 22 of the lease that called for reimbursement up to a maximum of \$25,000 if the City cancelled the lease, stating Council had agreed the City would not sustain any monetary expense if the lease were granted. Attorney Prather informed Council MCRC added the reimbursement clause after the last Council meeting.

Council discussed the School Board's intention to build a new school near the site and the possibility of using a portion of the land for a parking lot. Mr. Billy Dillworth, MCRC, discussed EPA's rules governing the monitoring of a landfill and his belief the site could not be used for another 10 years. But, Mr. Dillworth also indicated his willingness to waive the reimbursement clause if the School Board wished to utilize the lower section of the property. Attorney Prather suggested adding the following sentence to the end of Section 22:

The foregoing provisions are inapplicable if the property is acquired, taken or used by the School Board of Manatee County.

Attorney Prather also advised Council the Manatee County Radio Controllers, Inc. should provide a survey with legal description of the property being leased from the City.

MOTION: Mr. Williams moved, Mrs. Lancaster seconded and motion carried 5-0 to approve and authorize the Mayor to execute the Lease Agreement between the City of Palmetto and Manatee County Radio Controllers, Inc. with the amendment to Section 22 and conditioned upon receipt of a survey and legal description of the property.

16. APPROVAL OF SUB-METERING PER SECTION 29-40, CITY CODE (FEWTEK, INC. - RAINBOR MOBILE HOME PARK AND LONE OAK TRAILER PARK

Mr. Williams and Mrs. Lancaster voiced concern that the residents of the mobile home parks had not been provided the chance to speak on this matter. Mr. Laferte, FEWTEK, INC., advised Council the deadline for approving this request was October 1, 2002, after which a meeting would be held with the residents of the parks and they would have 30

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days to appeal. Attorney Prather advised there may be an issue because *Florida Statutes* permits the installation of the sub-meters, based on certain criteria, while the City Code does not prohibit the park owners installing the sub-meters. And the sub-metering would not be considered a resale of City services.

MOTION: Ms. Cornwell moved, Mr. Grace seconded and motion carried 3-2 to authorize and confirm pursuant to Sec.29-40, City Code, sub-metering ("resale") of utility services by Rainbow Mobile Home Park and Lone Oak Trailer Park upon the condition that the "resale" is in compliance with Sec. 723.045, *Florida Statutes*, as it relates to fees and charges, installation of meters is by a licensed plumber with proper City permits, and residents will not be charged for installation of sub-meters unless such charge is expressly authorized in the respective mobile home park's prospectus.

Council further instructed Mr. Laferte that any future mobile home parks expressing an interest in this issue would require Council approval on an individual basis.

17. RESOLUTION NO. 02-18

Attorney Prather advised Council this resolution required public notice, stating the topic should be tabled to September 23, 2002.

MOTION: Mrs. Lancaster moved, Ms. Bryant seconded and motion carried 5-0 to table Resolution No. 02-18 to September 23, 2002.

18. FRDAP PROJECT NO. F03412 - HIDDEN LAKE PARK

MOTION: Mrs. Lancaster moved, Ms. Bryant seconded and motion carried 5-0 to authorize the Mayor to accept the Hidden Lake Park FRDAP Project No. F03412 grant award and execute the project Grant Agreement.

19. FRDAP PROJECT NO. F03410 - LINCOLN PARK REC. COMPLEX

MOTION: Mrs. Lancaster moved, Ms. Bryant seconded and motion carried 5-0 to accept the Lincoln Park Rec. Complex FRDAP Project No. F03410 grant award, and execute the project Grant Agreement.

A copy of the Manatee County's agreement to furnish the \$150,000 match in in-kind services is attached hereto and made a part of these minutes.




Dear Mayor Whitesel:



Dear Capt. Davis:

Many of the questions in your letter that you presented to the City Council on September 16, 2002 have been overcome by events. The Council has now passed the General Fund budget, and decisions on spending plans for the City in fiscal year 2003 have been made. Nevertheless, I would like an opportunity to discuss with you and also your neighbors, if you wish, some of the considerations that went into the budget. You may be surprised to know that many of the alternatives you mentioned had already been addressed during the budget development period, and some of them are still being evaluated.

The issues raised in your letter portray one of the classic dilemmas of many cities like Palmetto: how to increase the services that the citizens want while decreasing, or at least not increasing taxes. For example, in your letter you noted, "Our roads and drainage conditions remain in a deplorable state in many areas." I would submit to you that you don't fix roads and drainage problems without citizens providing the funding.

Another dilemma for cities that is evidenced in your letter is that many citizens only know what is going on in their cities through what they read in the newspapers. Many folks don't have time to attend City Council meetings or Council budget workshops to find out what is really going on. I submit to you that the "proof of concept" that you asked for in your letter was provided many times over in the numerous public budget development workshops and Council meetings held prior to the passage of the General Fund budget on September 23, 2002. I'm puzzled by the so-called "discretionary spending" that you mentioned, because the budget for 2003 doesn't have any "nice-to-have" items in it. This budget, in my opinion, is the most fully documented and justified budget that Palmetto has seen in many years.
