A meeting will be held under the Attorney/Client Session provisions available under Florida's Sunshine Law, Section 286.011(8), Florida Statutes, on Tuesday, January 12, 2021, and beginning at 6:00 p.m. and lasting approximately one (1) hour at the request of the City's Attorney. This meeting shall be held in the Commission Chambers at City Hall, 516 8th Avenue West, Palmetto, Florida. This meeting shall commence at an open meeting and then will move into an Attorney/Client Session limited in attendance to the City Attorneys Mark Barnebey and Charles Johnson, who will meet in private with the City Commission (Tamara Cornwell, Sheldon Jones, Harold Smith, Tambra Varnadore, Brian Williams), Mayor Shirley Groover Bryant and a court reporter who will transcribe the full proceedings to be made part of the public record for release at the conclusion of the litigation for the purpose of discussing: settlement negotiations and strategy sessions related to litigation expenses in the following court case: Lincoln Memorial Academy, et al v. State of Florida, et al, 8:20-CV-309. At the conclusion of the private portion of the meeting, the meeting shall then reopen in public.

PURSUANT TO SECTION 286.0105, FLORIDA STATUTES, IF AN INDIVIDUAL DECIDES TO APPEAL ANY DECISION MADE BY THE CITY COMMISSION WITH RESPECT TO ANY MATTER CONSIDERED AT THIS MEETING, A RECORD OF THE PROCEEDINGS WILL BE REQUIRED AND THE INDIVIDUAL WILL NEED TO ENSURE THAT A VERBATIM TRANSCRIPT OF THE PROCEEDINGS IS MADE, WHICH RECORDING INCLUDES THE TESTIMONY AND EVIDENCE UPON WHICH THE APPEAL IS BASED.
